

HIGHLIGHTS (Percentages refer to year-on-year variations unless otherwise specified)

The BDL coincident indicator reached 287.1 in October 2016, compared with 284.2 in the previous month and 281.4 in October 2015. The balance of payments posted during the month a deficit of USD 680.2 million. Year-on-year, the consolidated balance sheet of commercial banks rose by 9.6%, and the deposit dollarization rate reached 65.1% at end-October. Bank interest rates decreased on LBP debit and credit accounts and on USD debit accounts, while they stabilized on USD credit accounts.

- ☒ The **balance of payments** posted a deficit of USD 680.2 million in October 2016. This was reflected in an increase in the net foreign assets of Banque du Liban by USD 51.2 million, and a decrease in those of banks and financial institutions by USD 731.4 million. In the year to October 2016, the BOP registered a cumulative deficit of USD 125.3 million, compared with a cumulative deficit of USD 2,166.2 million for the same period of 2015.
- ☒ According to figures released by the Ministry of Finance, net total **public debt** went up in October 2016 by LBP 174 billion, totaling LBP 97,068 billion at the end of the month. This increase stems from a rise in the LBP-denominated net public debt by LBP 306 billion, to LBP 53,337 billion at end-October, coupled with a decrease in the foreign-currency-denominated public debt by USD 88 million, to USD 29,009 million. Year-on-year, the net total public debt, the LBP-denominated debt and the foreign-currency-denominated debt grew by 6.6%, 3.2%, and 11.1% respectively.
- ☒ **Gross foreign-currency reserves of Banque du Liban** reached USD 42,764 million at end-October 2016, with an annual rise of 9.3%, or USD 3,645.4 million. Total foreign reserves, including gold, totaled USD 54,501.1 million. The average **US dollar exchange rate** remained stable on the domestic market, standing at LBP 1,507.50.
- ☒ **Interest rates** remained unchanged in October 2016 on all categories of Treasury bills and bonds. Accordingly, at the end of the month, yields stood at: 4.44% on the three-month, 4.99% on the six-month, 5.35% on the one-year, 5.84% on the two-year, and 6.50% on the three-year. On the Lebanese pound, bank interest rates fell to 5.53% on credit accounts (-5 basis points), and to 8.35% on debit accounts (-9 basis points). On the US dollar, these rates decreased on debit accounts, while they stabilized on credit accounts. Consequently, the USD weighted average lending rate stood at 7.06% (-14 basis points), while the USD average deposit rate remained at 3.43%.
- ☒ The **monetary aggregate M3** totaled LBP 194,079.3 billion at end-October 2016, rising annually by 5.5%, compared with 5.8% in September 2016. Bank credits to the private sector remained the main factor in money creation, along with credits to the public sector. Regarding money stock components, LBP-denominated deposits and foreign-currency deposits registered a growth of 3.7% and 6.4% respectively.
- ☒ The **consolidated balance sheet of commercial banks** reached LBP 301,006 billion at end-October 2016, with an annual rise of 9.5%, compared with 9.2% in September 2016. Resident and non-resident private sector deposits, as well as credits to the private sector, grew by 5.6% and 7.0% respectively. The **dollarization rate** of bank deposits reached 65.1% at end-October 2016.
- ☒ **Trade deficit** deepened by 1.3% and totaled USD 1,222.5 million at end-October, as imports progressed by 0.8%, to USD 1,479.2 million, while exports dwindled by 1.5%, to USD 256.6 million.
- ☒ Compared to October 2015, the volume of **cement deliveries**, indicator of the construction sector's current activity, and the area of **construction permits**, indicator of its potential activity, widened by 11.0% and 11.3% respectively.
- ☒ **Power production** expanded by 8.3% and reached 1,150.1 million kWh during the month.
- ☒ At **Beirut International Airport**, total plane traffic and passenger flow shrank by 6.1% and 3.7% respectively, as the number of incoming, outgoing, and transiting passengers dropped by 2.6%, 2.7% and 92.3% respectively. Airfreight narrowed by 10.1%.
- ☒ In October 2016, the number of ships and the volume of maritime freight at the **Port of Beirut** improved by 6.7% and 5.2% respectively.

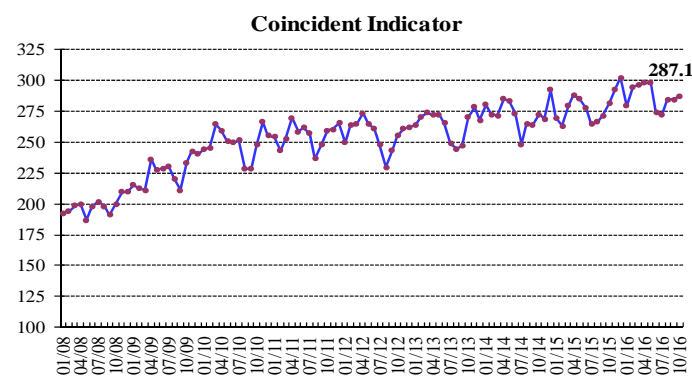
DIAGNOSIS

CLEARING HOUSE ACTIVITY

In October 2016, the total value of cleared checks decreased by 4.2%. The value of checks in foreign currencies fell by 7.5%, while that of Lebanese pound rose by 4.7%. From the total of cleared checks, the share of foreign-currency-denominated checks stood at 70.3%, declining by 3.4%.

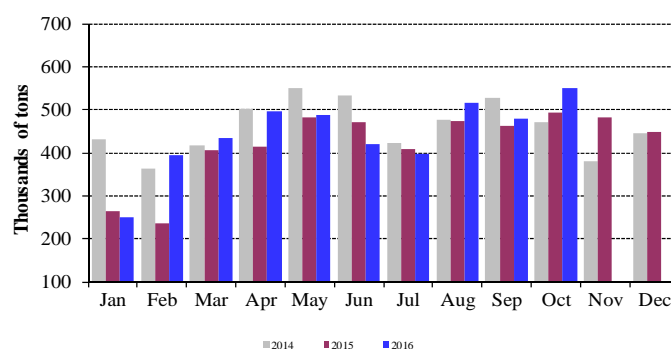
Year-on-year, the share of returned checks went up by 9.1%, accounting for 2.5% of the total value of checks at end-October 2016.

REAL SECTOR

CONSTRUCTION AND REAL ESTATE

Compared to October 2015, the volume of cement deliveries, indicator of the construction sector's current activity, and the area of construction permits, indicator of its potential activity, widened by 11.0% and 11.3% respectively.

Cement Deliveries



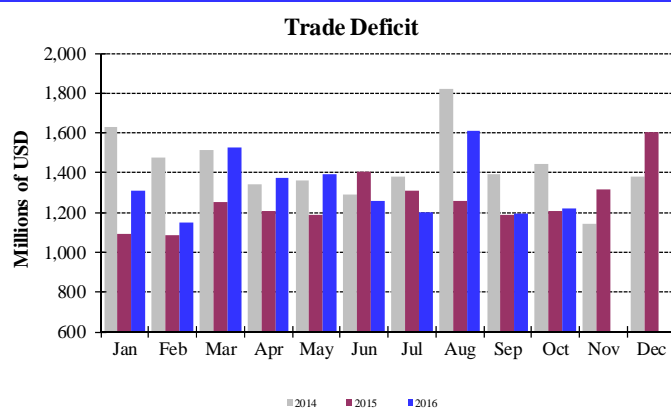

FOREIGN TRADE

Trade deficit deepened by 1.3% and totaled USD 1,222.5 million at end-October, as imports progressed by 0.8%, to USD 1,479.2 million, while exports dwindled by 1.5%, to USD 256.6 million.

Customs duties collected during the month grew by 1.0% and reached LBP 197.4 billion in October.

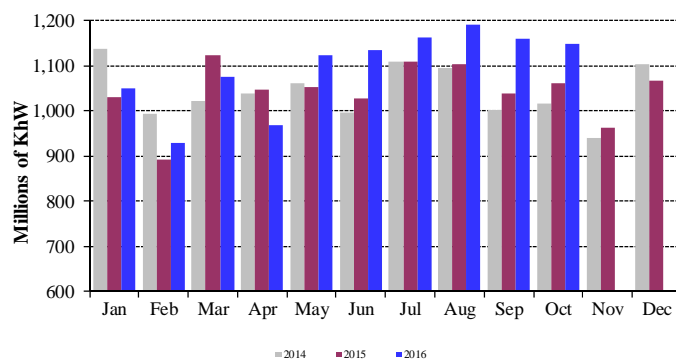

Monthly Electricity Production



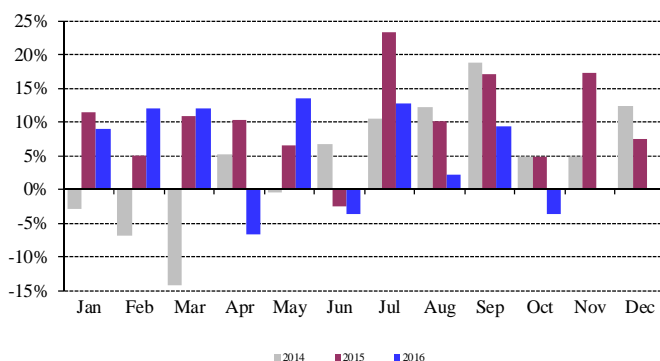

At Beirut International Airport, total plane traffic and passenger flow shrank by 6.1% and 3.7% respectively, as the number of incoming, outgoing, and transiting passengers dropped by 2.6%, 2.7%, and 92.3% respectively.

Airfreight narrowed by 10.1%, as incoming and outgoing freight contracted by 2.5% and 21.9% respectively.

In October 2016, the number of ships and the volume of maritime freight at the Port of Beirut expanded by 6.7% and 5.2% respectively. Incoming freight grew by 6.8%, while outgoing and transiting freight declined by 3.4% and 61.6% respectively.

This was reflected in an increase in the net foreign assets of Banque du Liban by USD 51.2 million, and a decrease in those of banks and financial institutions by USD 731.4 million. In the year to October 2016, the BOP registered a cumulative deficit of USD 125.3 million, compared with a cumulative deficit of USD 2,166.2 million for the same period of 2015.

Gross foreign-currency reserves of Banque du Liban reached USD 42,764 million at end-October 2016, with an annual rise of 9.3%, or USD 3,645.4 million. Total foreign reserves, including gold, totaled USD 54,501.1 million. The average US dollar exchange rate remained stable on the domestic market, standing at LBP 1,507.50.

Interest rates remained unchanged in October 2016 on all categories of Treasury bills and bonds. Accordingly, at the end of the month, yields stood at: 4.44% on the three-month, 4.99% on the six-month, 5.35% on the one-year, 5.84% on the two-year, and 6.50% on the three-year.

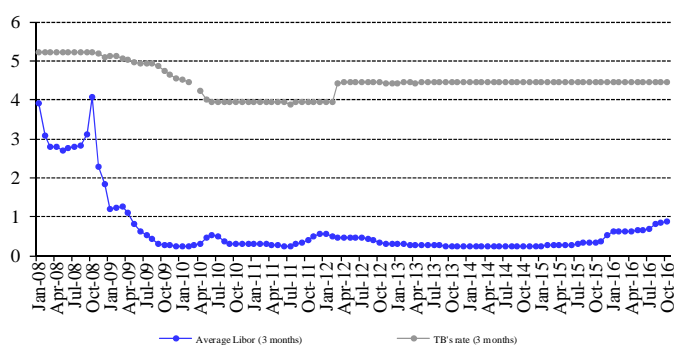
On the Lebanese pound, bank interest rates fell to 5.53% on credit accounts (-5 basis points), and to 8.35% on debit accounts (-9 basis points).

On the US dollar, these rates decreased on debit accounts, while they stabilized on credit accounts. Consequently, the USD weighted average lending rate stood at 7.06% (-14 basis points), while the USD average deposit rate remained at 3.43%.

As a result, the spread between the LBP and USD lending rates widened from 1.24 points in September 2016 to 1.29 points in October 2016. In contrast, the spread between the LBP and USD deposit rates shrank during the same period from 2.15 points to 2.10 points.

In October 2016, the three-month Libor rate reached 0.88%, compared with 0.85% in September 2016.

Yields on the 45-day and 60-day certificates of deposit issued by Banque du Liban recorded no monthly change in October, stabilizing at 3.57% and 3.85% respectively.

On the other hand, the Central Bank maintained the discount and Repo rates at 10.00% each, as adopted since December 2009.

MONETARY AGGREGATES

The monetary aggregate M3 totaled LBP 194,079.3 billion at end-October 2016, rising annually by 5.5%,

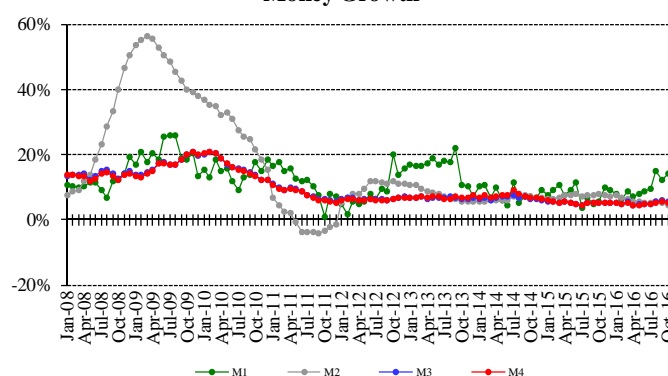

PUBLIC DEBT

According to figures released by the Ministry of Finance, net total public debt went up in October 2016 by LBP 174 billion, totaling LBP 97,068 billion at the end of the month.

This increase stems from a rise in the LBP-denominated net public debt by LBP 306 billion, to LBP 53,337 billion at end-October, coupled with a decrease in the foreign-currency-denominated public debt by USD 88 million, to USD 29,009 million.

Year-on-year, the net total public debt, the LBP-denominated debt and the foreign-currency-denominated debt grew by 6.6%, 3.2%, and 11.1% respectively.

BANKING ACTIVITY

CONSOLIDATED BALANCE SHEET

The consolidated balance sheet of commercial banks reached LBP 301,006 billion at end-October 2016, rising monthly by 0.81%, compared with 1.17% in the previous month. Year-on-year, it progressed by 9.55%.

VOLUME OF CREDITS

a-Commercial Banks

Credits granted by commercial banks to the private sector, resident and non-resident, went up in October 2016 by 0.06%, compared with 0.49% in the previous month. At end-October 2016, these credits reached LBP 85,453 billion, with a year-on-year increase of 6.97%. They were distributed as follows:

- Credits in Lebanese pound amounted to LBP 23,009 billion at end-October 2016, rising monthly by 2.07%, compared with 1.51% in September 2016. Year-on-year, they grew by 13.01%, and their share from total bank credits totaled 26.93%, compared with 25.49% in October 2015.
- Credits in foreign currencies regressed by 0.66% in October 2016, compared with an increase of 0.13% in September 2016. Year-on-year, they widened by 4.90%, reaching USD 41,423 million at end-October 2016.

b-Investment Banks

Credits granted by investment banks totaled LBP 2,117 billion at end-October 2016, as they improved by 0.03%, compared with 0.29% in September 2016. In comparison with October 2015, they rose by 2.78%.

VOLUME OF DEPOSITS

a-Commercial Banks

Private sector deposits at commercial banks by residents and non-residents decreased by 0.31% in October 2016, following a rise of 0.67% in the previous month. Year-on-year, their volume widened by 5.56%, and they amounted to LBP 237,666 billion at end-October 2016. They were distributed as follows:

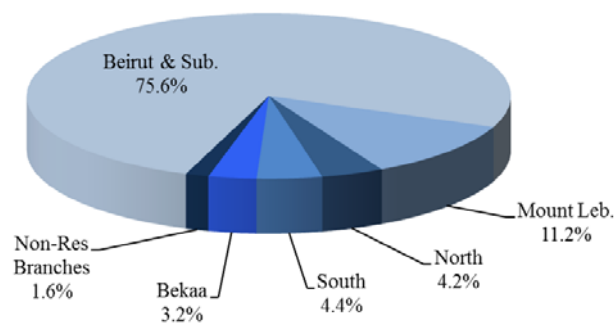
- Deposits in Lebanese pound decreased by 0.66% in October 2016 and stood at LBP 82,942 billion at the end of the month, compared with a slight increase of 0.03% in September. Year-on-year, they improved by 3.97%, accounting for 34.90% of total deposits, compared with 35.43% at end-October 2015.
- Deposits in foreign currencies regressed by 0.12% in October 2016, compared with an increase of 1.02% in September 2016. Year-on-year, they went up by 6.43%, totaling USD 102,636 million at end-October 2016.

b-Investment Banks

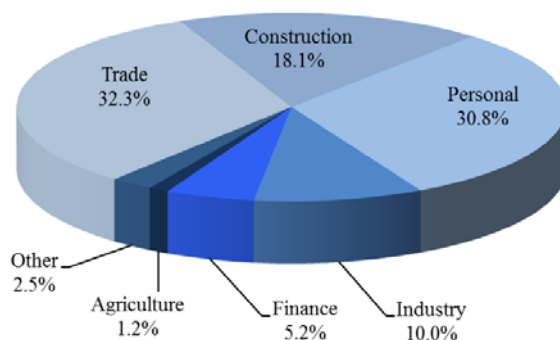
Private sector deposits at investment banks fell by 1.62% during the month, compared with an increase of 3.05% in September 2016. Year-on-year, their volume shrank by 3.69%, from LBP 3,128 billion in October 2015 to LBP 3,013 billion at end-October 2016.

CREDIT-DEPOSIT RATIO

At end-October 2016, total credits accounted for 35.96%

of total deposits, compared with 35.48% at end-October 2015, and detailed as follows:

- Credit/deposit ratio in Lebanese pound: 27.74%, compared with 25.52%.
- Credit/deposit ratio in foreign currencies: 40.36%, compared with 40.94%.

SHAREHOLDERS' FUNDS

Shareholders' equity went up by 1.35% in October 2016, compared with 0.23% in September 2016. Year-on-year, it grew by 8.72%, reaching LBP 26,688 billion in October 2016.

The capital/total asset ratio in commercial banks rose to 8.87% at end-October 2016, compared with 8.82% in September 2016 and 8.93% in October 2015.

The capital/total deposit ratio reached 11.23% at end-October 2016, up from 11.04% in September 2016 and 10.90% in October 2015.

Likewise, the capital/total credit ratio increased to 31.23% at end-October 2016, compared with 30.83% in September 2016 and 30.73% in October 2015.

DOLLARIZATION

The dollarization rate of bank deposits went up to 65.10% at end-October 2016, compared with 64.98% at end-September 2016 and 64.57% at end-October 2015.

In contrast, the dollarization rate of bank credits stood at 73.07% at end-October 2016, down from 73.61% at end-September 2016, and 74.51% at end-October 2015.

FINANCIAL MARKETS

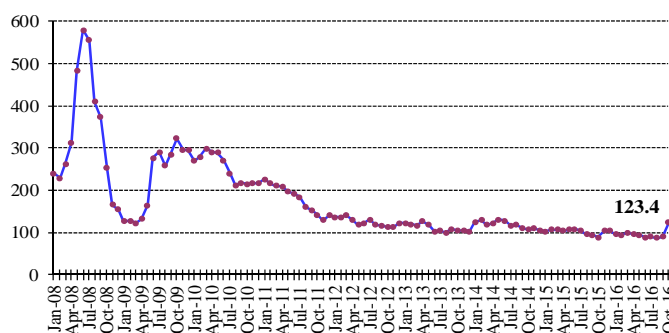

Market-Value-Weighted Index



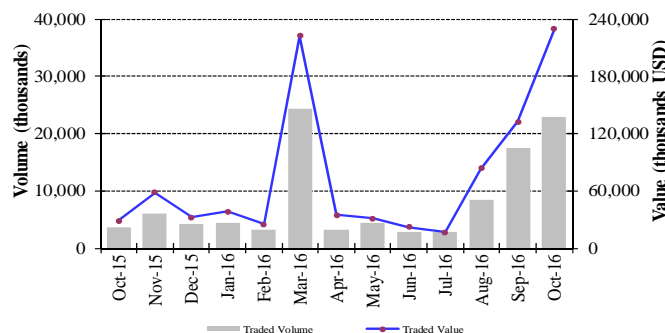

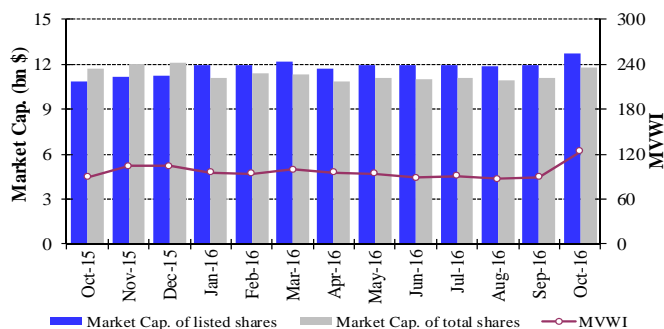

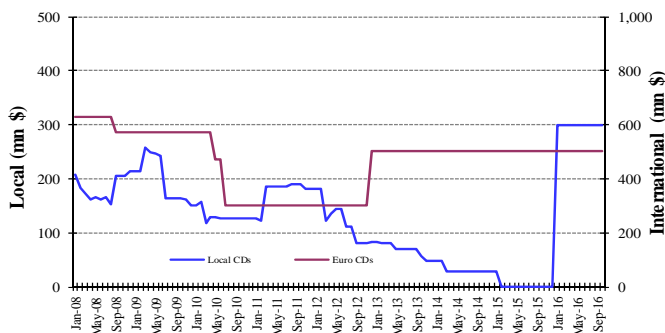

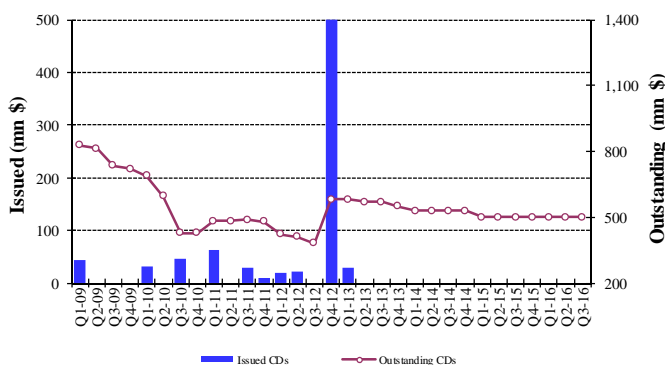

Issued and Outstanding CDs

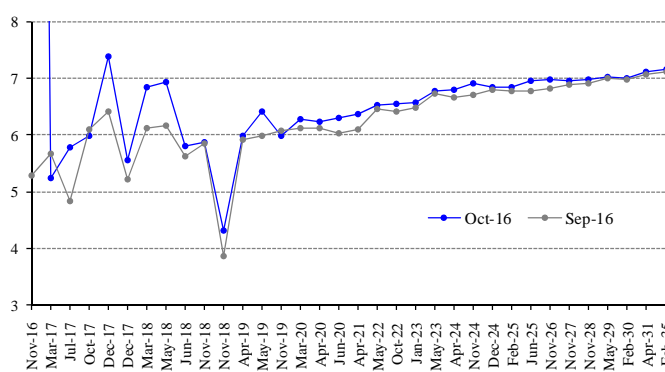
